### Role Descriptor for the Outreach Lead of AULC

AULC is run by an Executive Committee as detailed in the Constitution approved at the AGM in 2019 and updated and approved at an extraordinary AGM vote in 2025. This role profile should be read in conjunction with the Constitution available to download from:

The **Executive Committee** is made up of

- Vice-Chair (Ireland)
- Vice-Chair (United Kingdom)
- Treasurer
- Deputy Treasurer
- Secretary
- Attainment Lead
- Outreach Lead
- Scholarship Lead
- Social Media Lead
- Scotland Representative
- Wales Representative
- Teaching Representative
- Teaching Representative
- UCFL Representative (co-opted)
- Annual conference organiser (co-opted for one year)

The **Outreach Lead of AULC** is responsible for:

- a. advising the AULC Executive Committee on matters pertaining to outreach initiatives;
- b. liaising with Routes into Languages, SCILT, NICILT and Languages Connect;
- c. engaging with the languages Gateway team to actively promote outreach activities;
- d. liaise with the Social Media Lead to actively promote outreach activities;
- e. liaise with the Association for Language Learning (ALL), the Scottish Association for Language Teaching (SALT), and the language specific associations in Ireland;
- f. engage with member universities so as to build links between them and regional FE sector members.

The **Outreach Lead of AULC** shall be elected for three years, and may be elected for a further year, after which further nominations will be sought. No AULC member may serve on Executive Committee for more than a total of eight consecutive years. Terms of office will begin at the date specified in the advertisement.
