Role Descriptor for the Teaching Representative of AULC

The **Executive Committee** is made up of

- Treasurer
- Deputy Treasurer
- Secretary
- Attainment Lead
- Outreach Lead
- Scholarship Lead
- Social Media Lead
- Scotland Representative
- Wales Representative
- Teaching Representative
- Teaching Representative
- UCFL Representative (co-opted)
- Annual conference organiser (co-opted for one year)

The **Teaching Representative of AULC** is responsible for:

- a. advising the Executive Committee of opportunities and concerns directly impacting teaching staff
- b. acting as a point of contact for teaching colleagues and providing a direct voice for teaching staff
- c. identify ways of collecting teachers' thoughts and ideas regarding their roles and future opportunities
- d. advising the Executive Committee of support that teachers would find useful to enable them to continue to develop and maximise opportunities within the HE sector.

The **Teaching Representative of AULC** shall be elected for three years, and may be elected for a further year, after which further nominations will be sought. No AULC member may serve on Executive Committee for more than a total of eight consecutive years. Terms of office will begin at the date specified in the advertisement.
